



## Museum Guidelines & Tips for Parents

The Children's Museum Tucson welcomes you and your family to the Museum. We hope you have a fun visit filled with new experiences and discovery! We understand young children are in the beginning stages of socialization with others and want to provide a foundation for helping families reinforce positive social skills and behaviors. Therefore, the Museum asks all visitors to follow the basic Museum guidelines during their visit. Discovery Guides are here to facilitate a positive visit, and ask parents to supervise their children. If any guest needs assistance, please let a Discovery Guide know how they can help!

### General Museum Guidelines:

- Please use walking feet, kindness and inside voices while in the Museum.
- Children must stay with an adult chaperone at all times.
- Please note that the WEE WORLD exhibit is a special place for children 4 and under *only*.
- In the interest of others, please do not bring sick children to the Museum. We may ask you to leave if your child is ill, so please respect the health of others when considering a visit.
- Shoes are required for all children of walking age, even for little feet.
- Adults, please help children treat Museum materials with respect and put things back where they belong.

### Birthday Party Tips for Parents:

- You may arrive 30 minutes before your birthday party to set up. If you need any help with unloading or setting up please ask any of our Discovery Guides to help.
- Please bring your guest list with you the day of your party.
- Don't forget to bring your birthday candles, a knife for the cake, a cooler for your drinks, and anything else you may need.
- Please no food or drink in the Museum (water is permitted). Please enjoy your snack or lunch in the birthday room that you were assigned. Our front lobby may also be used for snacks.
- No piñatas, please.
